Masimo (NASDAQ: MASI) is a global medical technology company that develops and manufactures innovative noninvasive patient monitoring technologies, including medical devices and a wide array of sensors.

A key medical technology innovator, Masimo is responsible for the invention of award-winning noninvasive technologies that are revolutionizing patient monitoring, including Masimo SET® pulse oximetry, Masimo Rainbow Pulse CO-Oximetry and new Masimo noninvasive and continuous total hemoglobin (SpHb™) monitoring technology. We believe that Masimo SET® helps clinicians monitor in excess of approximately 100 million patients in healthcare settings around the world,1 and is the primary pulse oximetry technology at 17 of the top 20 hospitals listed in the 2017-2018 U.S. News & World Report Best Hospitals Honor Roll.2

Today, Masimo is publicly traded and employs over 4,600 people worldwide, with annual revenues of approximately \$800 million. Licensing agreements allow Masimo technology to work inside monitoring devices from a host of manufacturers, including Philips, Atom, Mindray North America, GE Medical, Spacelabs, and Zoll. Throughout its more than 25-year journey, Masimo's mission – to improve patient outcomes and reduce the cost of care – has remained strong.
