Curriculum development

Running After-school and Kindergarten

Using our in-house created curricula, we run an afterschool program for primary school children and a kindergarten program for pre-school children, at 4 models schools and 5 franchise schools.

We hire and train native English speaking teachers to teach our curriculum at our model schools, and we recruit and train teachers for franchise campuses, and we provide them with management advice.
