Frontier Spirit

The Founder, Dr. Yuichi Kurimoto, was the first international graduate of the University of Alberta, Canada. While he was a student there in the early Showa era, he was very impressed by the energy by which the Canadians were opening up to the western frontier. It was at this time that he adopted the motto "Frontier Spirit"—an encomium to the Canadians opening the frontier and a starting philosophy for his own new school. This motto continues to animate all of the schools in the Kurimoto Educational Institute.

"Frontier Spirit" refers to the school's mission to create leaders rather than followers, to nurture young persons who think creatively and independently and to impart to students the skills and qualities that they will need to become pioneers in the future. Specifically, "Frontier Spirit" refers to the spirit of a person who never gives up and who, by acting in an original manner, seeks to benefit humanity, society, and the nation.
