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## Hiroshima University

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### Company Description

Hiroshima University (HU) is a National University Corporation and a prominent comprehensive research university in Japan. It was established in 1949 as a new system university, integrating seven government-run schools and one municipal school in the Hiroshima area, including the former Hiroshima University of Literature and Science. The university's history is deeply rooted, tracing back to the Hakushima School established in 1874. Due to its unique and solemn location in Hiroshima, the city that experienced the world's first atomic bombing, HU operates under three fundamental principles: the "pursuit of peace," the "creation of new knowledge," and the "cultivation of well-rounded human resources for the global community." These principles define its critical role as an international comprehensive research university built on the foundation of peace.

Following its transition to a National University Corporation in 2004, Hiroshima University has developed into a major educational and research hub. It currently encompasses 12 undergraduate faculties (including Integrated Arts and Sciences, Law, Medicine, Engineering, and Informatics and Data Science) and four graduate schools (including the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences and the Graduate School of Advanced Science and Engineering). With over 3,400 full-time faculty and staff members, the university serves as a leading core institution in the Chugoku-Shikoku region.

In the realm of education, HU is dedicated to assuring the quality of its graduates through its unique goal-oriented educational program, "HiPROSPECTS (Hiroshima-university PROgram of SPecified EduCaTion and Study)." This system guarantees rigorous and high-quality learning, featuring a grading system that adds "Excellent (Shu)" to the traditional evaluation scale (A, B, C, D) and requires all undergraduate students to take the TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) to promote essential English language proficiency. The comprehensive curriculum is designed to systematically equip students with a broad general education and profound specialized knowledge. Furthermore, the university places a strong emphasis on fostering globally-minded individuals, actively providing opportunities for international collaborative research and overseas training to prepare students for leadership roles worldwide.

In research, fulfilling its historical mission as a university located in a bombed city, HU has devoted significant effort to research on the treatment of radiation exposure and peace science, primarily through its Research Institute for Radiation Biology and Medicine (RIRBM). This commitment makes a substantial contribution to human health and global peace. Concurrently, it drives cutting-edge research across diverse fields, including engineering, life sciences, and informatics, contributing significantly to the creation of new innovations. Contribution to the local community is also a vital mission. By collaborating with local industries and providing lifelong learning opportunities, the university acts as a "Center of Knowledge," deeply involved in regional revitalization. Hiroshima University continues to spearhead university reform for the future, developing global leaders who will drive world knowledge, and contributing to the realization of a sustainable society.
