For decades, GCF operated as a highly successful and foundational business segment of the paper industry giant, International Paper. In January 2026, GCF entered an exciting new chapter when it was acquired by the private equity firm American Industrial Partners (AIP) in a transaction valued at \$1.5 billion, officially establishing GCF as an independent, standalone enterprise. In June 2026, the company appointed Mike Doss as its new Chief Executive Officer, signaling a strong commitment to accelerating innovation and transforming GCF into an undisputed leader in the biomaterials industry.

Today, GCF operates on a truly global scale. The company employs approximately 3,300 dedicated professionals across eight countries and maintains a robust manufacturing footprint that includes seven pulp mills and two converting facilities strategically located in the United States, Canada, and Poland. In 2025, the business generated approximately \$2.5 billion in annual revenue, highlighting its immense scale and market presence.

2. **Papergrade and Modified Fibers:** Our premium softwood pulps and innovative modified fibers (such as the stiff, curly, and compression-resistant Helix® Fibers) serve the specific and demanding needs of tissue, towel, and paper manufacturers, ensuring the strength and softness consumers expect.
3. **Specialty Pulp and Biomaterials:** Beyond absorbent applications, GCF's specialty pulps are utilized as sustainable, bio-based raw materials in a wide array of industrial end-uses. These include textiles, filtration systems, construction materials, paints, coatings, and reinforced plastics.
