- Ensures the quality of work carried out throughout the packing and dispatch process is at high standards before being sent to the final customer.
- Assists in the disposal and control of security waste on site via manual destruction and machine use.
- Participates in training as required to maintain and improve the range of skills and knowledge required to meet the ongoing needs of the business.
- Maintains the health and safety of people within the area covered by the job holder by ensuring that safe and healthy practices are followed and that all aspects of company, site and legal occupational health and safety requirements are met.
- Loads and unloads vehicles using forklifts and hand trucks. Perform other forklift duties, manual handling, stock rotation etc.
