- Analyze potential problems and risks in logistics and trade operations (such as delivery delays, cargo damage), formulate emergency plans and organize drills (such as trade conflicts); coordinate local logistics resources in Malaysia (such as vehicles and warehousing)
- Plan logistics capabilities according to forecasts, including warehouse area, logistics facilities, personnel, etc., and make corresponding adjustments according to demand.
- Promote and participate in the standardization, process, systematization, and digital optimization of logistics processes to improve service quality and customer satisfaction;
