This role is central to enabling fast, reliable, and repeatable cloud delivery across engineering teams, with a strong focus on infrastructure-as-code and configuration management excellence.

- Design, build, and maintain Terraform modules for GCP infrastructure including GKE, Cloud SQL, Networking, IAM, and GCS
- Develop and maintain Ansible playbooks and roles for configuration management, application deployment, and operational automation
- Own the end-to-end cloud delivery pipeline: provisioning, configuration, testing, and deployment to production
- Integrate Terraform and Ansible workflows into CI/CD pipelines using Cloud Build, GitHub Actions, or GitLab CI
- Implement GCP IAM policies as code, enforcing least-privilege access and separation of duties across environments
- Manage Terraform state backends using GCS and enforce module versioning and registry standards
- Perform infrastructure drift detection and remediation using Ansible and Terraform plan workflows
- Build reusable, well-documented Terraform modules and Ansible collections for use across delivery teams

- Collaborate with security teams to embed compliance controls into infrastructure pipelines
 - Support GKE cluster provisioning and day-2 operations using Terraform and Helm
 - Participate in architecture reviews and provide IaC recommendations for new GCP workloads
 - Contribute to internal developer platform tooling for self-service cloud provisioning
