- Audit automated text highlights and system suggestions to correctly identify a company's specific sustainability information
- Analyze external news and reports to determine their impact on a company's sustainability score based on specific timelines and evaluation rules
- Align corporate evidence with global sustainability frameworks, such as Global Reporting Initiative (GRI), ISO 26000, European Sustainability Standards (ESRS), etc
- Review regularly updates regarding Ecovadis methodology and apply them to assessment process
- Perform quality checks on assessments to ensure adherence with prevailing methodology guidelines
- Own and drive personal achievement in alignment with departmental performance objectives
- Ensure to follow our integrity policy to produce a fair and unbiased scorecard
