【Position Overview】

The Senior Tax Analyst (Tax Analyst) is responsible for managing direct and indirect tax compliance, statutory reporting, and tax administration for WPIC's Japan operations. This role serves as WPIC's primary internal subject matter expert for tax matters in Japan, partnering with the Regional and Global Finance team, local stakeholders, and external tax advisors to ensure all filings, regulatory obligations, and reporting requirements are completed accurately, on time, and in accordance with local legislation, while supporting the integrity of the Company's overall financial governance framework.

【Key Responsibilities】

The primary duties and responsibilities of the Senior Tax Analyst(Tax Analyst) will be those that are typical of a professional in this capacity and include, but are not limited to, the following (other duties may be assigned as needed):

- Tax Compliance & Local Administration:
 - Coordinate with stakeholders in Japan to gather supporting documentation for tax and/or accounting records, and verify the correct tax categorization
 - Own the preparation and review of corporate income tax (CIT), indirect taxes (VAT), and withholding tax (WHT) filings in collaboration with external tax accounting firms, ensuring timely submission, completeness, accuracy, and compliance with local legislation
 - Manage the end-to-end statutory compliance process, coordinating internal stakeholders and external advisors to ensure all required filings are completed accurately and on schedule
 - Serve as the primary liaison between WPIC's Regional and Global Finance team, local business stakeholders, external tax advisors, auditors, and tax authorities on all tax-related matters within the market
 - Provide guidance to internal stakeholders on local tax requirements, documentation standards, and the tax implications of business activities to support informed decision-making and ongoing compliance
 - Review work prepared by external tax advisors, identify discrepancies or risks, and recommend appropriate actions to ensure accuracy and compliance with both statutory requirements and the Company's financial governance framework
 - Serve as the point of contact for tax administrative matters within the market in Japan
- Process Improvement & Cross-Functional Collaboration:
 - Monitor changes to local tax laws and support impact analyses on business operations
 - Identify opportunities for process automation and efficiency improvements within ERP modules
 - Promote collaboration between internal stakeholders to gather financial data and insights, and to maximize organizational efficiency
- Other high-level ad hoc duties, responsibilities, or projects as required or assigned by key executives within the organization (this is a dynamic role that involves learning of financial best practices in new markets; flexibility is therefore essential)
